IMPORTANT INFORMATION

All the costs of traveling, hotel accommodations and meals, transport from and to the airport are the responsibilities of the national federations or individual athletes. All ATHLETES and OFFICIALS will have to book their own hotel accommodation.

PARTICIPATION

All IFBB ELITE PRO competitors from ALL OVER THE WORLD, who have the Elite Pro Cards, are eligible to compete in this IFBB Elite Pro Competition by sending Declaration to the IFBB Elite Pro Office in Madrid: ifbbelitepro@ifbb.com (Ms. Diana Mozos).

The Declaration should include:

- Name, date and place of the contest
- 1 given name + 1 family name of a competitor
- Represented country (passport drawer)
- Category
- Date of birth
- E-mail address
- Mobile phone number

The deadline date for submitting the declaration is April 06th, 2018, 24:00 (midnight, UTC +2). The number of participating athletes is unlimited. The final decision to allow an athlete to compete in this event rests with the IFBB Elite Pro.

OFFICIAL ATHLETE REGISTRATION

The registration and weigh-in will be conducted on FRIDAY, APRIL 20th, 2018, BETWEEN 10:00 AND 18:00 HRS AT THE TRANSAMERICA EXPO CENTER, the same hall where the Expo will take place.

IFBB Elite Pro event will start on Saturday, April 21st, 2018, at 19:30.

All athletes will have to produce their **Passports** or other **Identity Document** with photography and IFBB **Elite Pro Card** at the Registration. Any athlete who has not yet purchased or renewed (for 2018) his/her IFBB Elite Pro Card will have to do so at registration. IFBB Elite Pro Cards are EUR €150 per year and are mandatory. Each athlete participating in the championship will be provided with a **wristband** or identification tag at the Registration. This identification **will allow daily admission** to the venue and shouldn't be lost. All posing music must be on an audio USB Flash Drive / CD only. The posing music must also be at the start of the CD or be the only music on the USB Flash Drive. Each competitor must affix his/her name on the USB Flash Drive / CD for easy identification. **The use of profane, vulgar and offensive language is strictly prohibited in the posing music.**

JUDGES

IFBB Elite Pro Judges should declare their readiness to work at this Elite Pro event by sending Declaration to the IFBB Elite Pro Head Office e-mail address: ifbbelitepro@ifbb.com (Ms. Diana Mozos) not later than February, 23rd, 2018, 24:00 (midnight, CET, UTC +1).

This Declaration should include:

- Contest name. date and place, judge would like to work at
- The name and surname of a judge (according to his/her passport)
- Represented country (passport drawer)
- Passport number
- Current place of stay (address)
- E-mail address
- Mobile phone number

After the deadline, the Elite Pro Head Office will analyze submitted Declarations and will compose the panel, taking into account the place of the contest and location of judges. Then, the Elite Pro Head Office will inform selected judges on the final decision and participating conditions.

All IFBB Elite Pro judges must have a valid **IFBB Elite Pro** Judge's Cards with the IFBB Elite Pro yearly judges fee of EUR €150 for 2018 to be paid through the Elite Pro website by PayPal: https://eliteproifbb.com/annual-membership/

All IFBB Elite Pro judges must be present at the Team Managers and Judges Meeting and hand over their Elite Pro Judge's Cards to the IFBB ELITE PRO Judges Committee representative present there. Any judge absents at this Meeting, will not be allowed to judge at this Elite Pro event.

VISA

of invitation will be made available, if required.

An athlete, included in an official National Federation team, who request and receive an invitation from the IFBB Head Office or the Organizing Committee of an IFBB sanctioned event for visa purposes, and uses that visa to unlawfully stay in the host country or any other country, will be subjected to the disciplinary proceedings and measures.

The relevant National Federation is responsible to carefully control the proper, legal use of the visa by his/her athlete and it will be subjected to a fine and/or a suspension, in case od any misuse and/or unlawful utilization of the same visa.

CLIMATE

The city has a monsoon-influenced humid subtropical climate. The city experiences four seasons. The winter is mild and sub-dry, and the summer is moderately warm and rainy. Fall and spring are transitional seasons. São Paulo is known for its rapidly changing weather. Daily mean temperature in April is 19.70C (67.50F). Average relative humidity 80%, average rainy days: 7.
